# MINUTES Wednesday, October 15, 2025 11:30 A.M.

The Lebanon County Prison Board was called to order at 11:30 a.m. by Commissioner Kuhn.

The following Board Members were present:

Michael J. Kuhn, County Commissioner Robert J. Phillips, County Commissioner Jo Ellen Litz, County Commissioner Robert M. Mettley, Controller

The following Board Members were absent:

Jeffrie Marley, Sheriff Pier Hess-Graf, District Attorney

\*First Assistant District Attorney Brian Diederick attended the meeting from the District Attorney's Office

Public Comment (s): John Rose of PA Prison Society, said results of a recent survey found that almost ½ of the correctional facilities that responded to the survey were short staffed.

It was moved by Commissioner Litz, seconded by Commissioner Phillips, to approve the minutes of the September 17, 2025 meeting. Vote unanimous.

Warden Tina Litz provided an updated Inmate Handbook to the Board and will be seeking approval to publish it in the next few months.

CGL, maintenance provider, continues to work on cell gate motors and has engaged with a local metal fabricator to prototype replacement parts.

Matt Hershey, Jubilee Ministries, addressed the Board with updates from Jubilee. Reverend Marilyn Nolte will be on a 3-month sabbatical leave from the facility. Jubilee will continue the same level of service to the Lebanon County Correctional Facility during this time.

Warden Litz presented treatment updates on behalf of Deputy Warden Davis. The LCCF continues to contend with aging-related health issues with inmates.

Tom Weber, CEO of PrimeCare Medical, gave the Board an update. Mr. Weber pointed out that the LCCF population has increased slightly, and medical call visits have increased commensurately. He also reported that the Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) program has doubled.

Tina Litz, Warden, submitted written reports of her activities for the month of September 2025. The Board reviewed this report.

Tina Litz, Warden, reported that the average daily inmate population for September was 315.17. The Board reviewed this report.

Written reports on the commissary and the canteen were submitted by Rebekah Bowsman, Fiscal Technician. The commissary average weekly sales for a four (4) week operating period, during the month of September 2025 were \$3,868.48, commission amount from August was \$5,058.14.

Heather Diehl, Deputy Warden of Operations, submitted written reports of her activities for the month of September 2025. The Board reviewed this report.

Rebecca Davis, Deputy Warden of Treatment, submitted a written report for the month of September 2025. The Board reviewed this report.

Edward Potter, Director of Training, submitted a written report giving his activities for the month of September 2025. The Board reviewed this report.

Robert Gibson, Detail Officer, submitted a written report. The Detail Section worked a total of 1,650 hours during the month of September 2025. The Board reviewed this report.

Sgt. Edward Bartashus, Kitchen Sergeant, submitted a written report for the month of September 2025 giving a breakdown of cost of meals served and items donated.

Captain Scott Hocker, Director of Security, submitted a written report for the month of September 2025. The Board reviewed this report.

Grant Verbitskey, Director Work Release, submitted a written report for the month of September 2025. Mr. Verbitskey reported that there are eight (8) inmates employed within the community on the work release program and three (3) inmates seeking employment. Two (2) travel passes were issued during this period. The Board reviewed this report.

Rev. Marilyn Nolte, Chaplain Manager, submitted a written Chaplain's report for the month of September 2025. The Board reviewed this report.

A 2025 Statistical Summary Report from PrimeCare Medical was submitted.

CGL, submitted a written building maintenance report for the month of September 2025. CGL completed three hundred and eighteen (318) work orders during this period. The Board reviewed this report.

Stephanie Warner, Teacher from Lancaster-Lebanon Intermediate IU13, submitted a written monthly report on the High School Age Education Program for September 2025. The total number of students enrolled in the Emotional Support (E.S.) Program was one (1) and the Alternative Education Program was zero (0) students. The Board reviewed this report.

Ken Travis, High School Equivalency Instructor from Lancaster-Lebanon Intermediate IU13, submitted a written monthly report on the Community Education Program for

September 2025. Total sessions to prepare students for the HiSET exams were twelve (12), six (6) students scheduled for the next GED/HiSET testing, and fourteen (14) request slips were received. The Board reviewed this report.

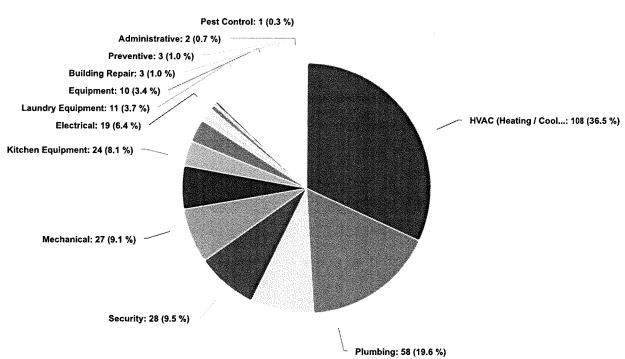

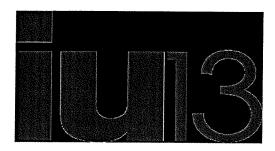
