



Route 72 / Cornwall Road Corridor Study Survey



The Lebanon County Planning Department as staff support for the LEBCO MPO (Lebanon County Metropolitan Planning Organization) and its programs has partnered with WSP and is conducting a transportation study of the Route 72 and Cornwall Road corridors between Oak Street in Lebanon and Rt. 419 in Cornwall & West Cornwall.

Route 72 is a north-south principal arterial connecting Lebanon to Lancaster and the Pennsylvania Turnpike, while Cornwall Road is a parallel corridor serving local and regional traffic. Both corridors have experienced growth, congestion, and safety challenges.
